Suburban Detroit land parcel goes up for sale

A rare piece of developable land in suburban Detroit is going up for sale, with an auction slated for June 7 for the Farmington Hills parcel, according to a press release. The site is about 10.5 acres and is close to retail that includes Sam's Club, Home Depot, Whole Foods, and Bed, Bath & Beyond. The site could be developed into residential, retail, or mixed-use and the city is open to working with developers. Madison Hawk is handling the live, open-outcry auction.
